Cohousing is like going back to the old-fashioned sense of a neighborhood where everyone knows each other and kids play outdoors. Neighbors consciously commit to living as a community, while the physical design encourages both social bonding and honors individual space. Private homes contain all the features of traditional homes, but residents also have access to extensive common facilities such as open space, avocado orchard, playground, garden, studio space, workshop and a common house (which includes kitchen, dining area, library, kid's room, TV room, and guest rooms).
